# Admission 2015-2016: required by the PhD program (Time limit: July 31st. h.18.00)

#### Then:

• Step 1 (Deadline July 24th - Required by the Central Administration of the University)

Register with the University information system.

We specifically stress that candidates holding foreign degrees have to provide additional documentation. Also, notice that the access of foreign candidates to positions without financial support is facilitated; see the <u>Call for application</u>.

- Pay the application fee, then go to Step 2.
- Step 2 (Deadline July 31st. h.18.00 Required by the PhD program)

Follow this link and complete the application online. Deadline July 31st. h.18.00

You will be asked to provide names and email addresses of two professors willing to support your application, and not belonging to the Board of Professors of the Doctoral program. Your references will be contacted immediately upon your submission of the form, and asked to send their letters in electronic format by September 1st.

### Selection

There will be no written examination.

On the basis of the documentation received, the selection committee will prepare a ranked list, which will be published on this web site by September 16, 2015. The presence of the Candidates on September 16 is not required.

Candidates in the list are invited to the oral exam, beginning on September 17. The day and the time of the interview of each candidate will appear in the list announcement. If candidates wish to have their interviews performed remotely (e.g., via skype) they should send by e-mail as soon as possible (time limit September 1) a motivated request to the Coordinator of the Ph.D. program (daniele.andreucci@uniroma1.it).

The candidate will be questioned on his/her scientific interests (past and future), and on background topics on related technical matters.

# **Ranking**

Candidates will be evaluated out of a total of 80 points: 40 for the past experience, based on the information in the online application form and in the recommendation letters; 40 for the oral examination. More details can be found in the <u>Call for application</u>.

Minimal rank for admission: 21 points in each evaluation.

Candidates ranked in the final list will be contacted by the Administration to finalize their enrolment, as explained in detail in the <u>Call for application</u>. Notice that candidates ranked past the number of available positions may be eventually enrolled if other candidates renounce.
